4. To Consider Approval of Minutes of the meeting held on 25th September 2017 (previously circulated)

RESOLUTION: The minutes of the previous meeting were agreed as a true and accurate record and were duly signed by Cllr Clothier.

5. To Receive a Brief Report from Ward Councillor J Lester

Ward Cllr Lester advised that health podcasts for young people had been launched today. Work is continuing to get the University project off the ground. Cllr Lester is cabinet member for Childrens Health and Wellbeing and all partners in Herefordshire are meeting to ensure that challenges are addressed and good results obtained. The plan currently goes to March 2018 so is being refreshed to take it forward involving all of the community. At the 16th November Herefordshire Council cabinet meeting the main topic of the meeting was the acquisition of land and compulsory purchase for the road joining the A465 & A49.

An update was given on Herefordshire Councils financial position and the challenges it faces, particularly the number of Looked After Children in the county which is currently 308 with costs of £40-£60k per year per child.

7.1 To Consider Planning Applications referred for comment:

8. Pixley and District Neighbourhood Development Plan

8.1 To Receive an update on the NDP

The draft plan is ready for Regulation 14, a six week public consultation. Environmental assessments have been undertaken and reports sent through. A copy of the draft plan, a consultation letter, flyer and comments form have been produced. Fliers will be put through all letter boxes advising residents about the consultation and advising that copies are available to view online, in the parish churches, at the Nest and at The Masters House in Ledbury, and where they can send their comments. The comments received from this consultation are reviewed and the draft plan amended as necessary. It should reach Regulation 16 stage around March 2018. After a further six to nine month period where it undergoes a further consultation with statutory consultees, independent examination and referendum, it is then adopted.

9.2 To Discuss Permanent Residency of Holiday Lets in the Parishes and Rates Applicable

Cllrs are aware that some properties in the parishes classes as holiday lets are being used as permanent residences and wonder if they are paying less in business rates than they would in council tax. If they only pay business rates then nothing is collected from them towards the parish council precept.

10. Highways and Footpaths

10.1 To Receive Report on A4172 Speed Survey Meeting held 15th November

A number of parish councillors together with Cllr Lester met with representatives from ADL, Balfour Beatty and the Safer Roads Partnership to view and discuss speed on the A4172. Speed recordings had previously been taken where the limit is currently 60mph but not where it is 50mph. It would be interesting to see if road users abide by the 50mph limit. The Safer Roads Partnership and ADL reports contradicted one another with regards to the 85th percentile. None of the representatives had spoken to Gloucestershire Council to ask how and why they reduced the speed limit to 50mph. Cllr Durkin advised that he would support any argument to reduce death and injury on the roads but cannot guarantee that speed limits will be reduced.

RESOLUTION: Cllr Clothier is to draft a letter, which the clerk will circulate to all councillors and upon agreement send from the parish council to Barry Durkin at Herefordshire Council saying that the survey did not go far enough in its scope and including stats such as the number of entrances, width of road, topography of the area, the Farm Park, Hereford Trail, increasing volume of traffic and large amount of slow moving traffic and rush hour peak time speeds and Cllr Durkin will ask for further investigation.

Also if the parish council wish to undertake a traffic regulation order for the A4172 this could cost up to £15000 so a contingency for this is to be included.
